MEDICAL EMERGENCIES-A.M.

How Confident are YOU in Responding to Medical Emergencies in YOUR Dental Office?

This course will provide information in dealing with MEDICAL EMERGENCIES for dental health professionals. Physical evaluation, dental office preparedness, and common medical emergencies will be addressed. Audience participation will include demonstrating their assessment skills through prevention, recognition, and management of medical emergencies by methods of video and MOCK simulation exercises.

At the conclusion of this course, the learner should be able to:

- Recognize the medically compromised patient and take the necessary precautions for treatment.
- Prepare a dental office for potential medical emergency situations
- Identify a specific medical emergency and be able to treat with the proper basic life support and definitive care until the emergency medical services (EMS) arrive and/or other disposition decided.
