“The Crucial Role of Hygienists in Associations Between Periodontal Infection and Systemic Health”

With Speaker Dr. Wenche Borgnakke, DDS, MPH, PhD

Wenche S. Borgnakke, DDS, MPH, PhD is an Assistant Research Scientist at the School of Dentistry at the University of Michigan. She is a consultant to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Since 2004, she has been a member of the joint CDC/AAP (American Academy of Periodontology) workgroup that has created case definitions for periodontal disease for use in surveillance of populations, which increasingly are regarded as the worldwide standard. Dr. Borgnakke's research focuses on relationships between oral and systemic health, and she recently has conducted extensive literature reviews on these associations as well as on dry mouth. Dr. Borgnakke has lectured nationally and internationally. She is a co-author of a chapter in the new book that was described on the front page of the OCDHA Spring Newsletter named "Periodontal Disease and Overall Health: A Clinician's Guide". The chapter she co-authored with Drs. George W. Taylor and Dana T. Graves is titled: "Association between Periodontal Diseases and Diabetes Mellitus".
