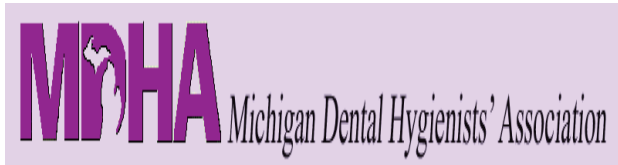


Medications and Pain Management (1:30 pm – 3:30 pm)
