Mucosal Maladies: Identification and Management course content:

This presentation will focus on evaluation, treatment and follow-up of various, common lesions affecting the oral mucosa—with specific emphasis on gingival pathology.

Dr. Michael R. Doctor was born and raised in northern Michigan. He received his D.D.S. degree from the University of Michigan School of Dentistry in 1985. He practiced general dentistry for three years prior to returning to the University of Michigan for specialty training and teaching in the Department of Periodontics.

Upon completing his periodontal residency in 1990, Dr. Doctor join the practice of Dr. Vaughn McGraw and the team at Northern Periodontics & Implant Dentistry. He has engaged in extensive continuing education with emphasis on periodontics, implantology and temporomandibular disorders.

Gingival Architecture: Diagnosis and Treatment course content:

Ever notice someone with a "gummy" or "toothy" smile? What causes this? Should it be treated or observed? This talk will aim to answer these questions and more about gingival architecture.

Dr. Bruce Edwards is originally from Cape Breton, Nova Scotia. He received his dental degree from Dalhousie University in Halifax followed by two years of private practice in general dentistry. He then completed the periodontal residency at the University of Michigan.

Upon completion of the program, he practiced as a periodontal specialist for two years in Saskatchewan before joining the practice of Northern Periodontics and Implant Dentistry. Dr Edwards is a Diplomat of the American Academy of Periodontology and a fellow of the Royal College of Dentists in Canada. He is experienced with all aspects of periodontal and implant therapy.
